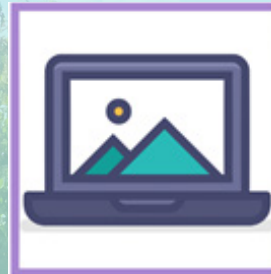


Core Equipment for all Sixth Form Students

Sixth Form Students are expected to use folders with dividers and A4 notepads / paper to organise and store their work.

Students are expected to provide their own stationary and we require all students to purchase the following items:

- Pens
- Set of highlighters
- Folder(s) as required
- Dividers and notepads as required



Laptops

We want to ensure you are ready to study and have the best possible chance to complete your work, so we are asking every student, where possible, to purchase a laptop to help with their studies. We appreciate that this is a major investment, but it is also one we feel will have a significant positive impact on your time with us.

You can purchase one yourself, but we will also be offering the opportunity to get one via the Academy which will mean that VAT of 20% will be taken off the cost – a significant saving. Any student that is unable to purchase a laptop themselves can apply for a Bursary (details on the next page). Please note that it is not a requirement at this stage to have a laptop, just a recommendation. If students are unable to purchase one, this will not be a barrier to learning as there is plenty of IT available within school and we will work to support you.



Communication

Communication between Sixth Form and home is crucial. Please ensure that you provide us with accurate mobile phone numbers and email addresses and notify us of any changes throughout the year.

We like to keep both students and parents / carers informed about Sixth Form life. Primarily, we use an app called ClassCharts so please ensure that both students and parents/ carers download this. Login details for students and parents/ carers will be issued once you start at the Academy. This app provides you with your timetable, homework that has been set and will also be used for messaging. We will sometimes send an SMS for urgent messages, and Email is used for longer messages and letters that need to be sent home.

You will be able to contact us directly through the ClassCharts app or via telephone or email. Please **always** inform us of reasons for student absence (illness or medical appointments) or if you ever have any questions or queries.

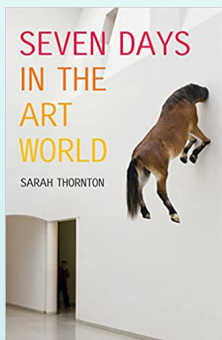
Requirements

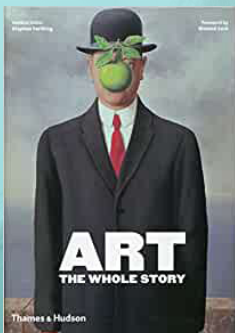

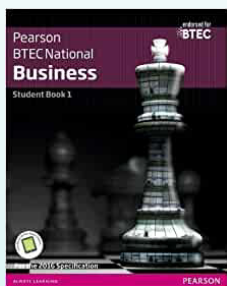

Deadline - All equipment should be purchased within the first three weeks of your course starting.

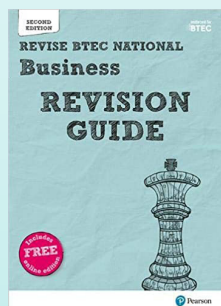

Year 13 - £85

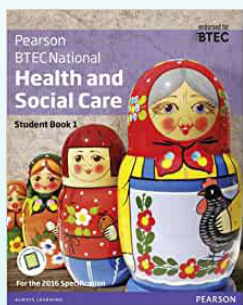

Equipment

Required to be purchased for the start of the course:



• Good quality SLR Camera (one that has interchangeable lenses). The department have some Nikon lenses, so we would advise a Nikon where possible. A good place to start is the Nikon D3400/3300, either new or second hand. Canon also do an equivalent Canon EOS 1300D, which would be ideal too. You will need a lens which will cover most standard topics; the standard kit lens (18-55) you receive with these cameras will be fine. If you wish to purchase a new camera, you can purchase through the Academy and not pay VAT (take 20% off the cost online). You will, however, need to ensure that you have the funds ready for the first day of term. You can also apply for a Bursary to help pay for a camera – please see the Bursary application form included in the Welcome Pack.

• You will be encouraged to work digitally throughout the course, but can work in a sketchbook. This can be purchased through the Academy.

• Pencil case of basic equipment – range of drawing pencils, black broad / medium and fine line pens, glue stick, rubber, sharpener, white gel pen, biro, highlighter etc.



• 16GB SD Card – SanDisk Ultra SDHC Memory Card Up to 80 MB/s, Class 10 FFP, 16 GB, Black/Grey.

Professional Cookery

This is a practical course and there is a charge for your equipment and ingredients for the two-year course.

Year 12 - £175 (covers cost of Chef's Whites, your own knives and ingredients)

Year 13 - £150 (covers the cost of ingredients for much more practical based lessons)

This means all your ingredients will be provided for you for the vast majority of your practical work and recipes. There may be the odd occasion where you need to provide your own ingredients due to your personal cooking choice.

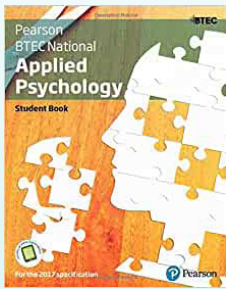

It is advised that students agree to the option of initials on their garments to eliminate the possibility of lost items. Additional items can also be purchased at any time.

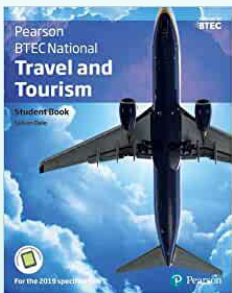
