Dear Parents / Carers

Sarum Academy French department is excited to announce that we are organising a day trip for students to Bolougne, France. This trip will be a great opportunity for your son/daughter to visit France, experience the culture and practice the French language they have been learning this year. The students have made excellent progress in French and this trip enables them to not only travel to a foreign country at relatively low cost but also an excellent immersive cultural experience of what they have been learning.

The trip will include a visit to the Boulangerie Le Fournil to learn how traditional French patisserie treats, such as Croissants and Pain au Chocolat are made, a visit to the chocolaterie "Les Chocolat de Beussent" and a walk around Bolougne's town centre, where students will have the opportunity to purchase French souvenirs.

The coach will leave the Academy very early on **Thursday**, **23**rd **June** (exact times to be confirmed). We will be travelling first to Dover, where we will board a ferry to Calais, France and will then travel on to Bolougne. The coach will arrive back at the Academy the same evening.

The full cost for the day will be £77.00 per student. This will be payable in an initial £17.00 deposit to secure booking for the trip and two further installments of £30.00. To keep the cost low, we have opted not to purchase food in France, so please ensure your child brings a large packed lunch. We also recommend a small amount of spending money, in Euros, for the purchase of souvenirs. We recommend no more than 15 Euros.

Your son/daughter will **not** need their own passport, as we will be travelling on a collective (group) passport for all students.
