ClassCharts

You should now be able to log into ClassCharts. With this you will be able to see in real time when your child has been awarded House Points and when they have homework set. You can also use ClassCharts to message tutors and teachers and it is a quick and easy way to communicate.

Homework

Homework will start from Monday and you should expect your child to receive English, Maths and Science homework every week. Other lessons will set homework roughly every four hours of classroom learning and will be recorded on ClassCharts.

If students need any support at all with doing homework there is a Homework Club which runs from 3pm – 4pm in room W1.
