<u>Year 7 – Year 10</u>

It can be very difficult to access Maths without a specialist teacher to guide you, so we have come up with a couple of ways you can approach your learning when working for temporary periods at home.

Firstly, take a look at the pupil sheet relevant to your Year group and the current term, this shows the work the class is completing along with examples of what that may look like. In the bottom right hand corner, we have given the section of mathsworkout you can practise this work from. All the exercises are self-marking so all you need to do is write out the questions, show your working out and mark as you go. We then ask you to submit your work to your teacher.
