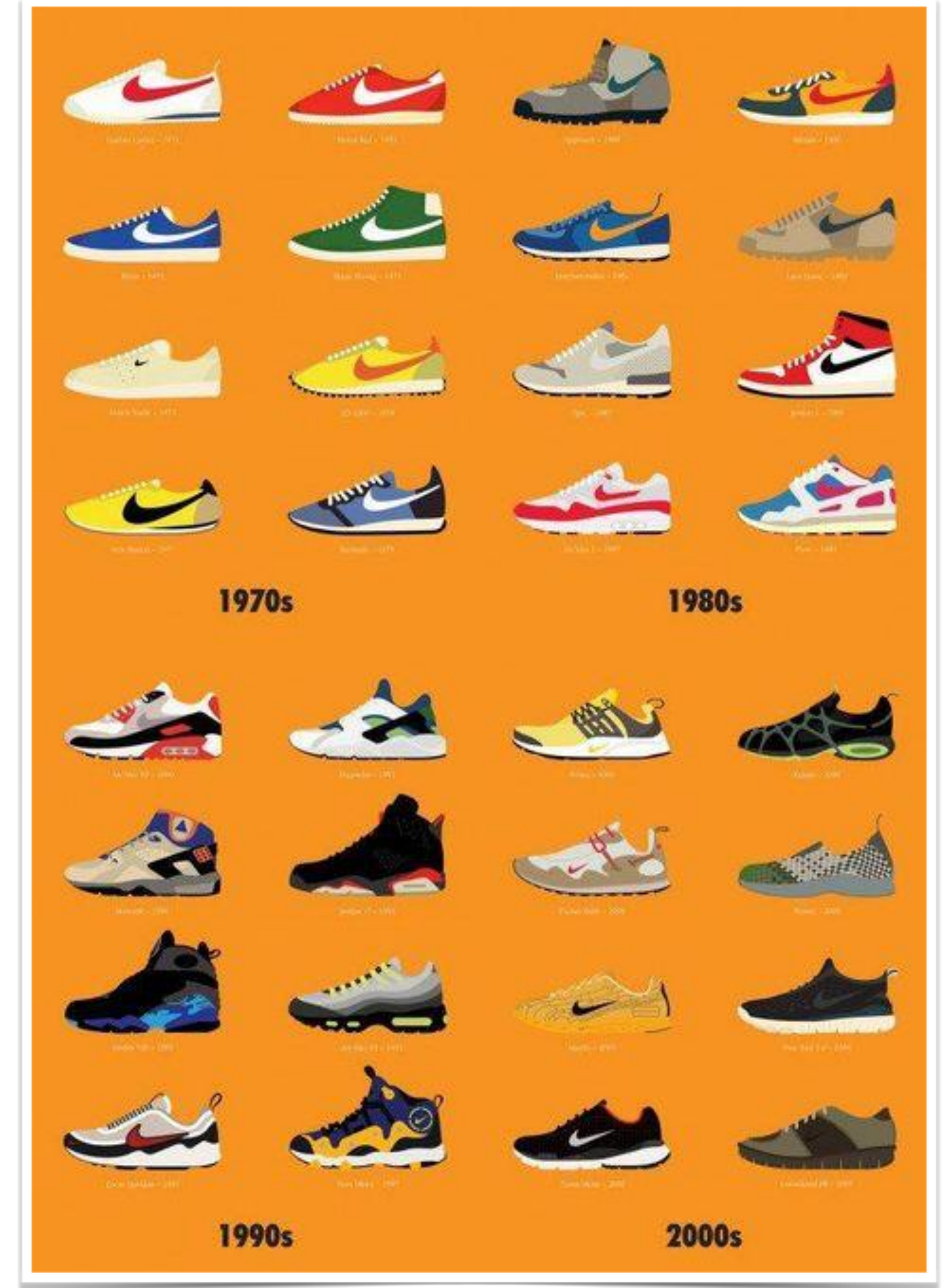

Draw out a light outline of a trainer. Now find as many coloured paper, fabric, newspaper and magazines to create your own trainer collage as shown in the image.

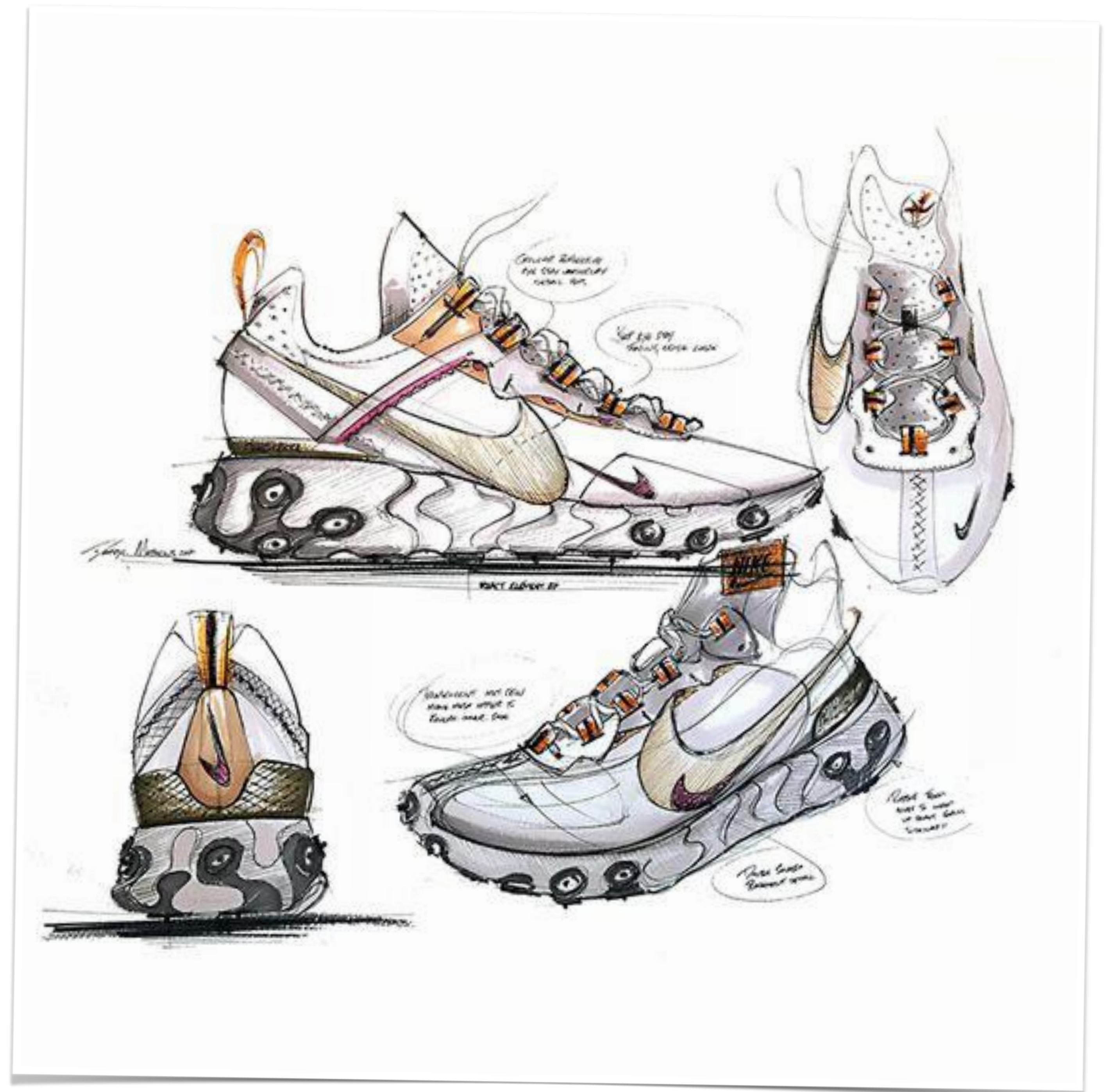
Artist tip: Why not try ripping paper to create different edges?

Task 6

Task 1

YWBAT: Explore and engage with your environment

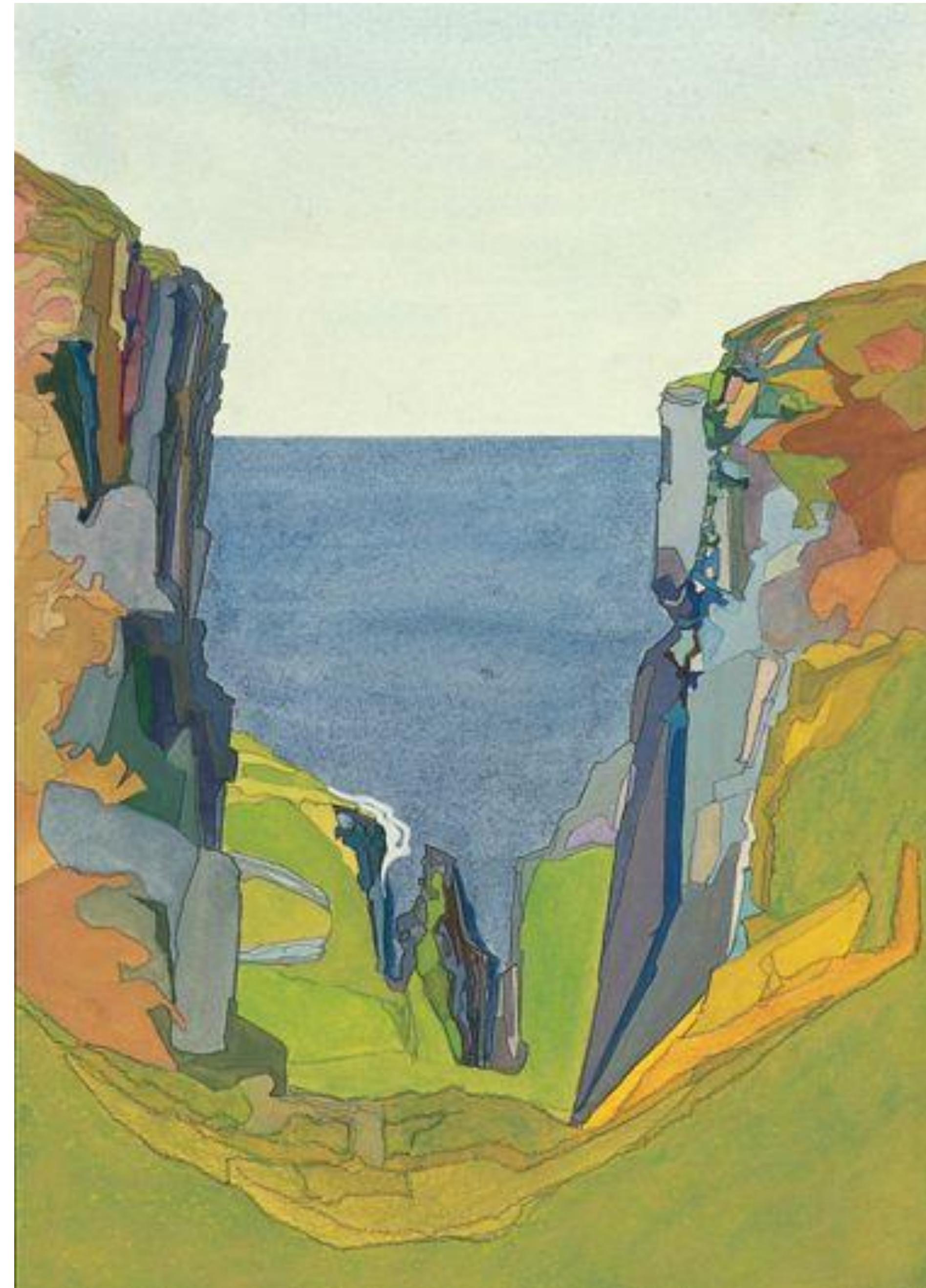
- Experiment with drawings. Using the images you have taken complete a series of drawings.

YWBAT: Explore and engage with your environment

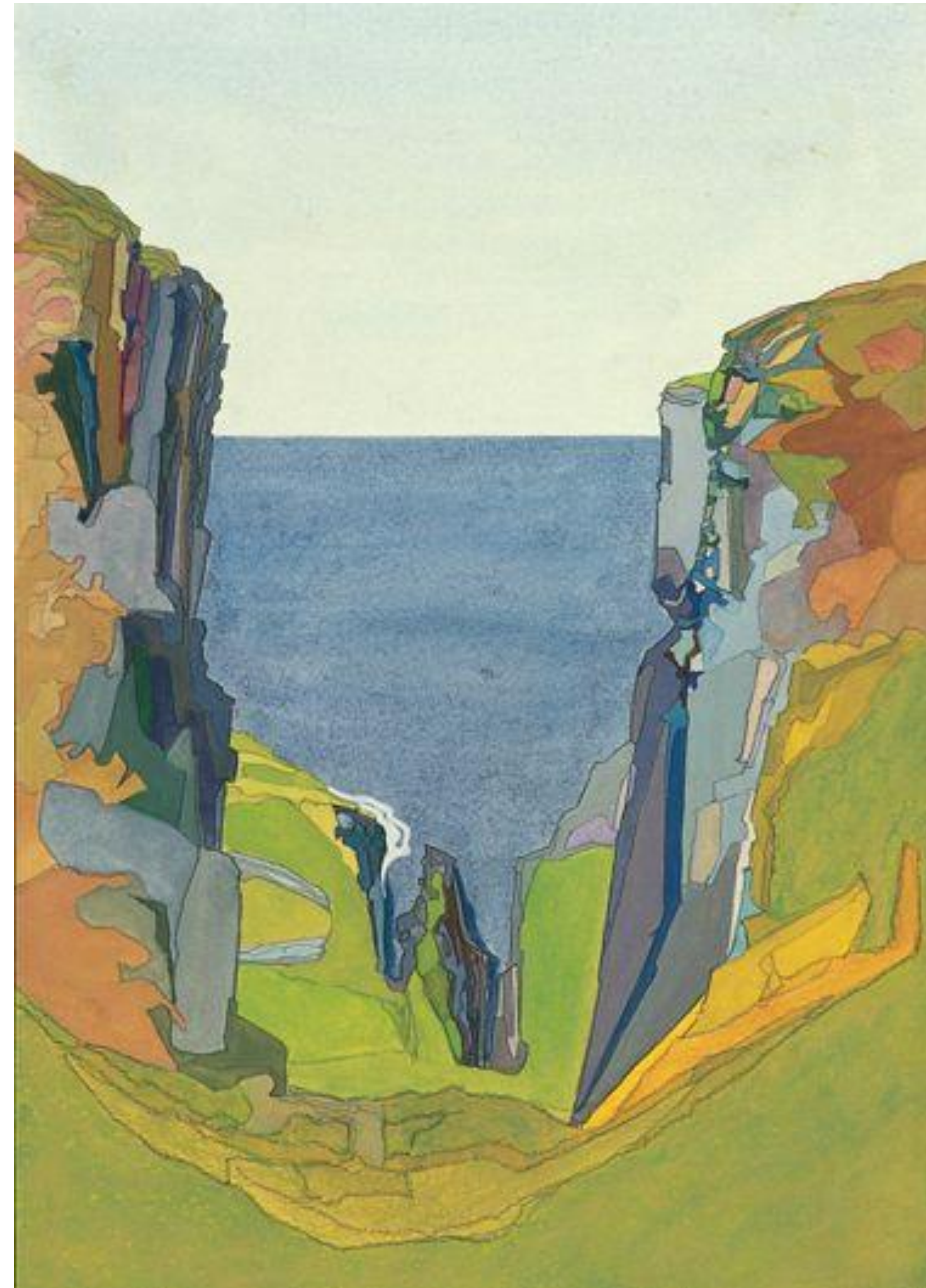
- Research the work of Artist Phillip Hughes whose work is inspired by the landscape. Look at how he uses colour, is it realistic?
