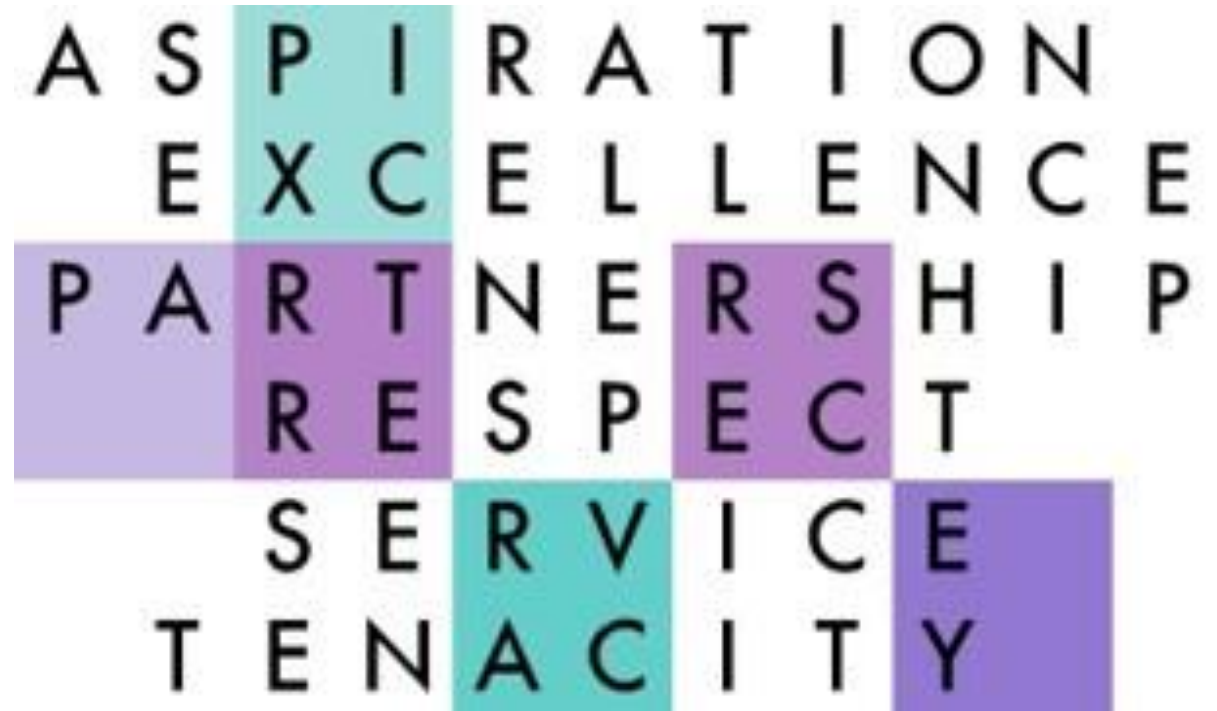

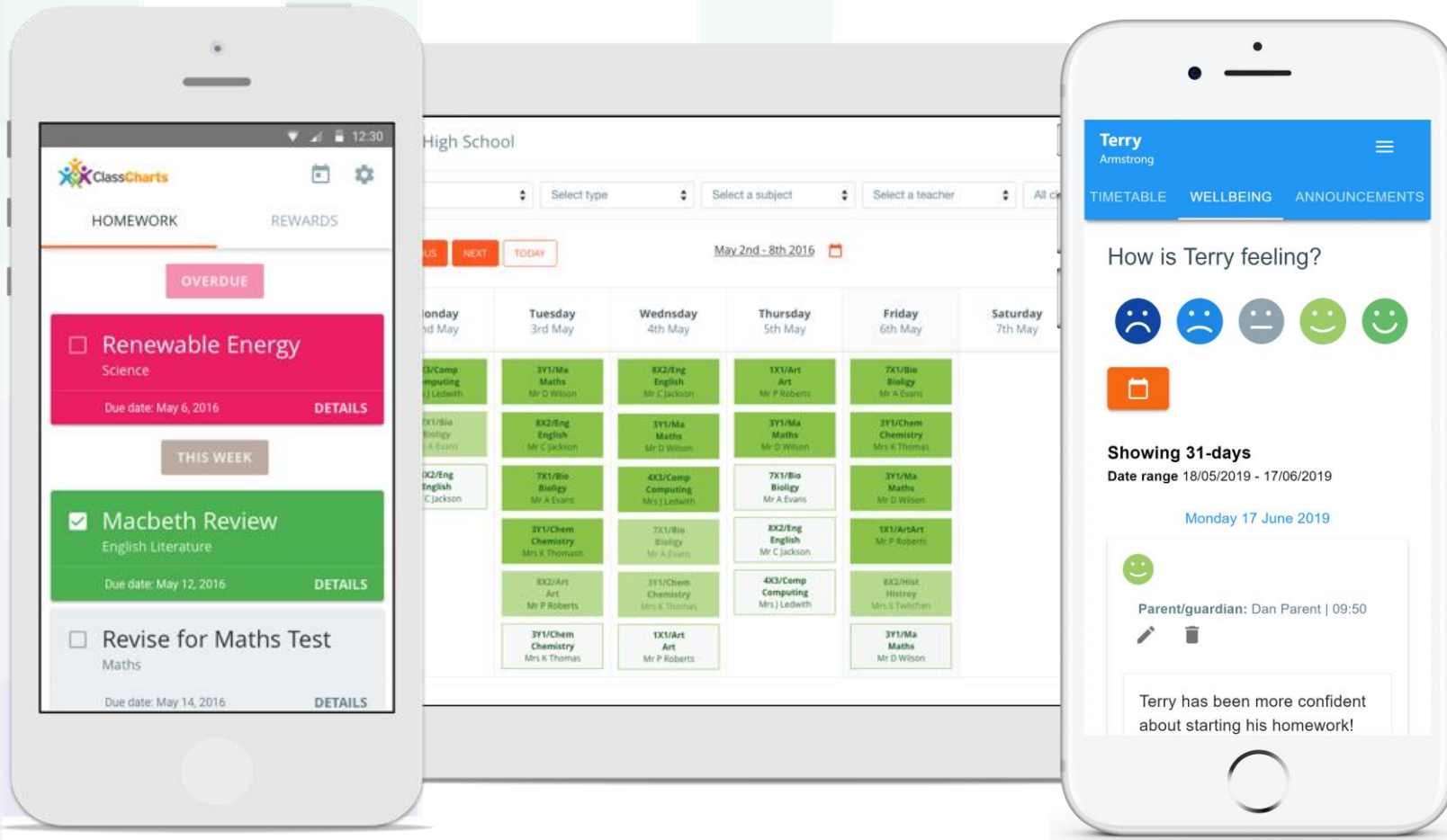
# **Your child's tutor**

- Class Charts is an *app* that enables us to communicate with students and parents about many aspects of school life.
- It contains much information, including; attendance, behaviour, student wellbeing, timetables, announcements and homework.
- It also allows students and parents the ability to communicate with tutors, teachers and other staff at school.

# How do I access it?



- Accessible via a web browser or an app on your phone.

**Parent Pay** is a secure web application that allows parents to make online payments.

We use this platform to notify you of any items that you need to pay for your child.

This can include school ties, school meals and school trips.

You will be able to pay for the items with your credit / debit card, via Direct Transfer or with Parent Account Funds.

Once you have received the activation details, you can log on at ***[www.parentpay.com](http://www.parentpay.com)***.

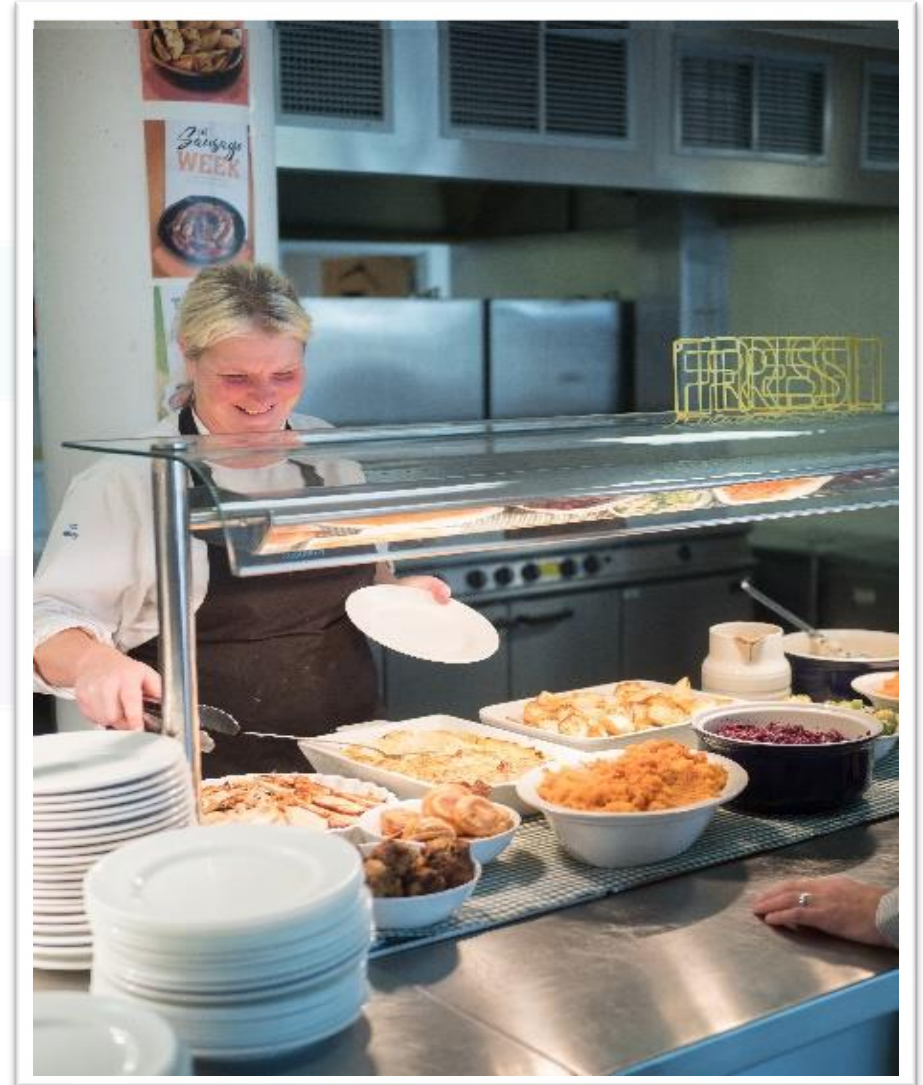
# Our Award Winning Canteen

# Attendance Matters

Attendance rewards – Students are awarded a stamp for every week their attendance is good or improving.

This can earn extra non-uniform days or a ticket for the end of term raffle.
